- Plenary speaker- Sir Rory Collins, University of Oxford

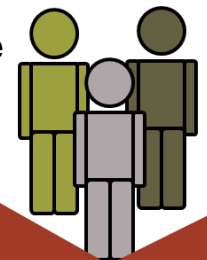
