

# NINJA-P Update

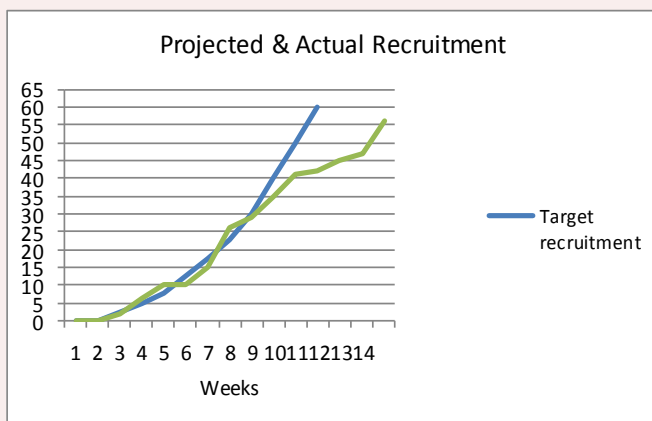
# July 2015

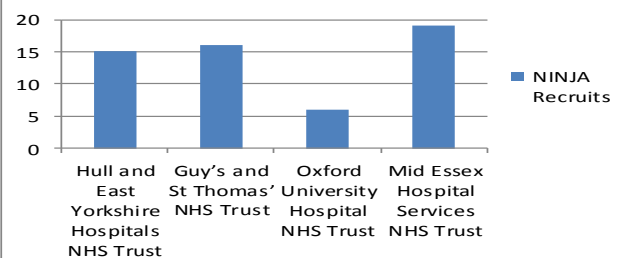
**NINJA-P Top Tip:** With the summer holidays starting, please remember to try and schedule a patient's follow up for a time where the parents will be able to bring them back in! The window for 2 week follow up is 10 to 20 days and for the 30 days follow up is 25 to 40 days!
